REQUIREMENTS FOR 'THE GEN' TRAINING FACILITY

COURSE TIMES: 7:30am - 5:30pm

All students will be required to sign-in to the facility daily. Training attendance is recorded each day, and your trainer will provide you with the attendance record.

Structural fire boots are required for live fire training. If you do not own a pair, you will be asked to provide your size prior to the course commencing. ARG will provide the boots prior to fire training commencing.

REQUIREMENTS

Trainees are required to bring the following each day:

- Clear medium impact safety glasses
- Lace up steel/composite toed work boots
- Long sleeve Hi Vis shirt and pants OR rescue overalls
- General purpose gloves

Recommended trainee items:

- Water bottle
- Stationery (pens, notebook)
- Morning tea and lunch (tea/coffee/milo provided)

PROVIDED BY ARG

All task-related PPE and safety devices are supplied by ARG to our trainees. This equipment is the property of ARG and must be inspected and maintained before, during, and after use.

PARKING


